SCORSESE AND DI CAPRIO SHALL COLLABORATE AFTER 6 SUCCESSFUL FILMS TOGETHER

FOR ADAPTING DEVIL IN THE WHITE CITY

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USPA NEWS - The news has just been confirmed, after the rumour said Leonardo DiCaprio and Martin Scorsese will meet soon on movie sets for the sixth time. They shall reunite to adapt the called "The Devil in the White City" from Erik Larson novel, released in 2003.

SIX SUCCESSFUL COLLABORATIVE MOVIES REUNITE SCORSESE AND DI CAPRIO-----

Sixth time's the charm for Leonardo DiCaprio and Martin Scorsese. The actor and director have teamed up to make five acclaimed movies, and they're reuniting once again for "Devil in the White City."-----

Deadline reports that Paramount has optioned the rights to Erik Larson's nonfiction book about a serial killer in Chicago in the late 19th century. DiCaprio will play Hh Holmes, who murdered between 27 and 200 people, mostly single young women.-----Produced by Paramount Studios, the film is in the studios of the pipes for a while. Leonardo DiCaprio is actually attached to the project since 2010, the year he bought the movie rights. Furthermore, the script had already been around Hollywood over the years, Tom Cruise and Kathryn Bigelow y being an attached time. As for adapting the screenplay thriller, it was entrusted to Billy Ray, to who screen-played "[?]Captain Phillips" and "Hunger Games."

The movie is set against the backdrop of the 1893 World's Fair, and also tells the story of fair architect Daniel H. Burnham. Holmes, who works with Burnham, builds the World's Fair Hotel and uses it as a means of luring in his victims. It was a nightmarish place that had a gas chamber, crematorium, and dissecting table.

The story of "The Devil in the White City" takes place in 1893, during the organisation of the World Exhibition in Chicago, and runs parallel to the architect's destiny works manager, Daniel H. Burnham and that of HH Holmes (DiCaprio), a hotel owner suspected as a serial killer and of killing between 20 and 200 guests. Sold over two million copies, the book had been translated into seventeen languages.

For his part, Martin Scorsese finds his favorite actor Leonardo DiCaprio, successor to his groin Robert de Niro. Their collaboration has always been successful, from "Gangs of New York" in 2002, "Aviator" in 2004, "The Departed" in 2006, "Shutter Island" by 2010 and "The Wolf of Wall Street" in 2013, which earned him five Oscar nominations in 2014.
